## **Suggested Financial Contribution Guidelines for Associated Labor Organizations**

Affiliates of the Labor Campaign for Single Payer are expected to financially contribute to the organization in accordance with the following guidelines:

<b><u>Organizations with an annual budget that is:</u></b>	<b><u>Annual Contribution:</u></b>
\$5 million or more	\$10,000
Less than \$5 million but greater than \$3 million	\$ 5,000
Less than \$3 million but greater than \$1 million	\$ 2,000
Less than \$1 million but greater than \$500,000	\$ 1,000
Less than \$500,000 but greater \$100,000	\$ 500
Less than \$100,000 but greater than \$50,000	\$ 250
Less than \$50,000 but greater than \$10,000	\$ 100
Less than \$10,000	\$ 50

### **Coalitions and Advocacy Organizations (e.g. labor councils, retiree groups, constituency groups, workers centers etc.):**

Large (e.g., State Federations or CLCs with more than 50,000 members):	\$500 per year
Medium (e.g. CLCs with more than 10,000 members, national groups):	\$250 per year
Small (e.g. local groups, retiree organizations):	\$100 per year

In addition, individuals who support the principles and mission of the Labor Campaign for Single Payer are encouraged to make a minimum annual contribution of \$50 per year.
